Kia ora Parents and Whānau,

We are excited to introduce you all to the digital portfolio app Seesaw. Seesaw is a simple, digital way that parents and whānau can engage with your child's school work via your cellphone, tablet or computer. All our tamariki already have a Seesaw account and over the last two weeks we have all been learning how to use the app and it's features. Students will post work to their Seesaw account and, using your own unique login details, you, and only you, will be able to view and comment on your child's work. Tamariki are able to post photos, videos and pictures to their Seesaw, and they can also use voice recordings to talk about their learning and explain what they are doing.

Seesaw does replace the previously used 'big books' and our goal is that Seesaw will provide everything that the big books did, with the added bonus of parents and whānau being able to check them from home, like, comment and receive notifications whenever your child has added something to their Seesaw. Please be patient as we develop our proficiency in using Seesaw, we are confident you will enjoy the greater connection you will have with your child's learning.

Your child has brought home their login information today so that you can access their Seesaw, if you don't receive this please let us know and we can send that information via text or email.

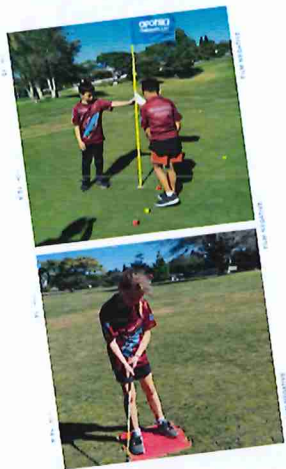
